GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO KEEP YOU & YOUR BRETHREN SAFE

1. **Be like Jesus.** Have love, compassion, mercy and respect for your brethren.
2. Before you enter the auditorium, please either wash your hands and/or use the Germ-X hand sanitizer provided in the foyer.
3. Please refrain from hugging, shaking hands, pinky promises, or touching (especially, without consent from another).
4. Please respect those who choose to wear a mask or are practicing safe distancing. Be courteous of the space between you and your brethren.
5. Please follow the 6 ft guidelines while seated. Locate and sit where the yellow tape is indicated on the pew. If you see a larger family sitting on one pew, then please skip the next pew in order to maintain distances.
6. **DO NOT** touch or try to grab the babies, please. (Unless you are related). Mothers are already nervous as it is, so please don't make them feel uncomfortable coming to worship.
7. Communion has been prepared with utmost care and safety. There are two cups, the bread is in the bottom cup. When finished, either leave the cups in the cup holders on the pews or dispose of them in the trash as you exit.
8. If you do not feel safe, or you still feel uncomfortable attending worship services at this time, then do not come. The elders respect your decision for your own safety. Livestream services will continue to be offered at all regular meeting times.
9. As of May 20, all 50 states have begun lifting corona-virus restrictions. Even before this, Florida had already deemed churches as "essential services," allowing them to offer services. The right to assemble in worship is also protected by the U.S. Constitution. NO State, County, or City ordinance can supplant this protected right. The U.S. Attorney General is also currently upholding churches' constitutional rights and is protecting them from local government overreach/abuses in this matter.
10. Beginning May 31st, Margaret Street Church of Christ will be opening its doors to the public for worship services at 10:00 am. Bible Study hours (Sunday 9:00 am & 6:00 pm; Wednesday 6:30 pm) will still be available via Livestream and Zoom meetings. The elders are requesting that all visitors, who are not members of MSCOC, please use the balcony at this time, until further notice.
