PERIOD: 1055-538 BC PLACE: Israel, Babylon


PHASE: Mosaic; (4 phases) PUBLIC: Exiles / Mankind

KEY POINTS:





KEY PASSAGES:

KEY PHRASES:

"Thou reignest over all"

"Did that which is evil"

"Worship" (3x)

Faithfulness (1 Chr) unfaithful (2 Chr)



GREAT LESSONS:

Genealogies = reminder how God fulfilled promises

Genealogies = God knows us by name!

Levite's roles (1 Ch 6:48) - roles in the church

David's victories (1 Ch 18) = 1 Corinthians 3:6

"If" (2 Ch 7:12-22) = Rev 2:10

Seeking counsel (2 Ch 10:1-19) = Matt 6:33
