Confront sin; warn God's people judgment is coming;
and to offer pardon to all who repent
Foretell destruction of Israel and of Judah

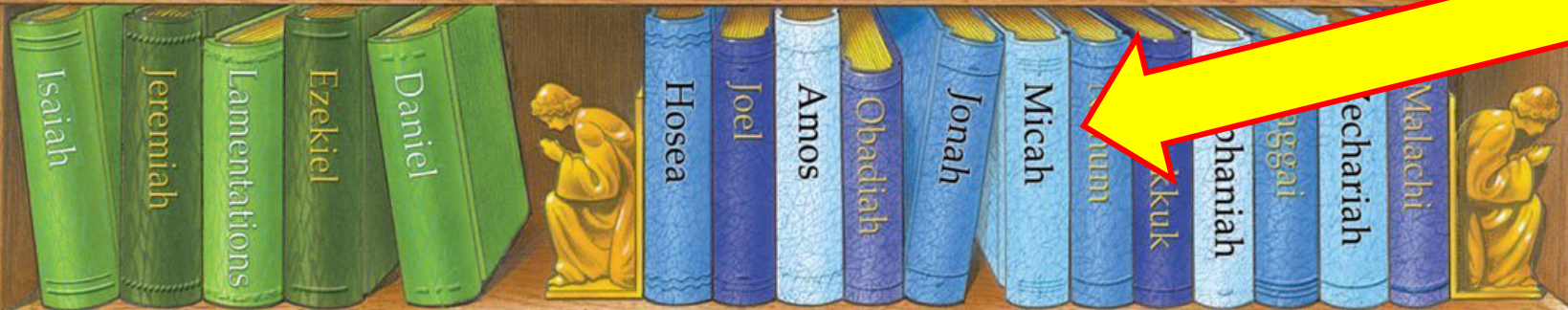

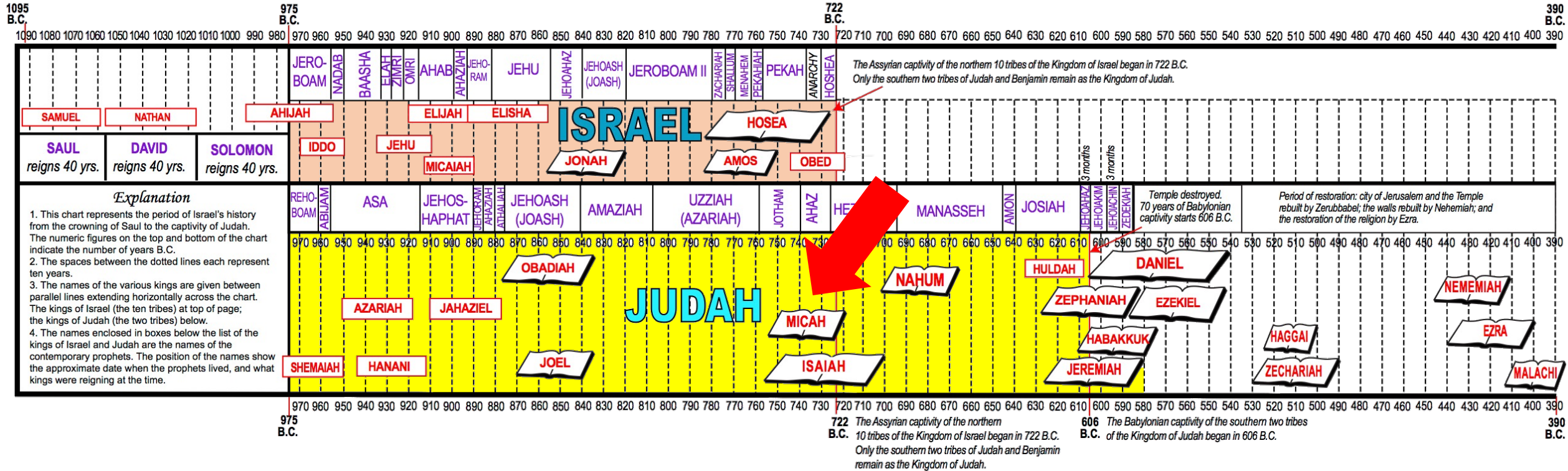

PARTICULARS:

The "Bethlehem Prophet" (Micah = who is like unto Yahweh)

Micah was a contemporary of Isaiah and Hosea

Micah is like Isaiah in miniature. Both prophets addressed the same people and problems - many "parallel passages: Is 1:2 & Mic 1:2; Is 7:14 & Mic 5:2

Message alternates between doom and hope.

Prediction of Judgement	Prediction of Restoration	Plea for Repentance

GREAT LESSONS:

Promise of the Messiah (5:2)

Promise of the Eternal Kingdom (4:1-5)

Worship God and only God (1:5)

God warns before He sends punishment.

Being blessed or being cursed is our choice

We must be in right relationship to be heard (3:4)

Be careful to whom you listen (3:5)
