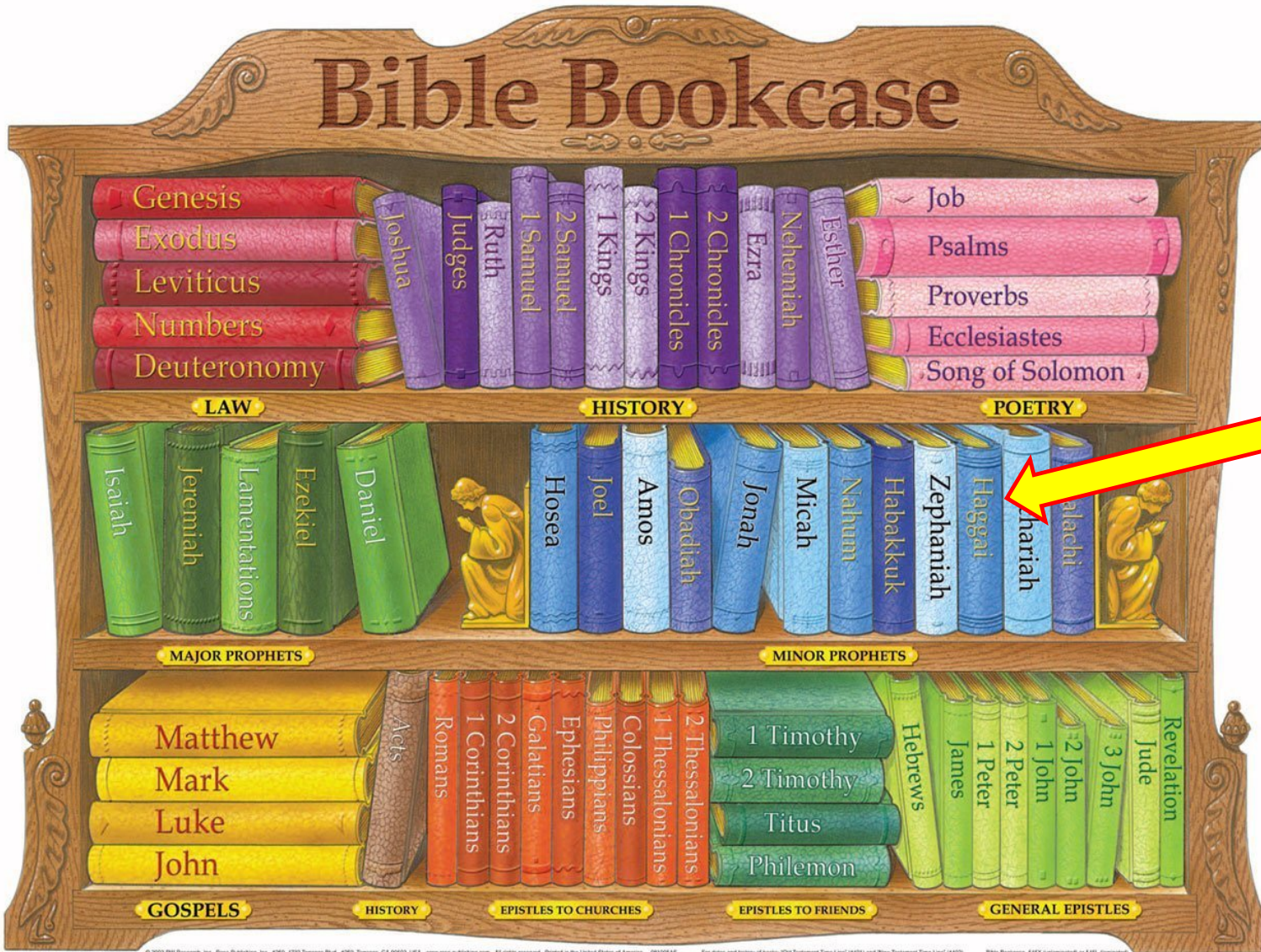

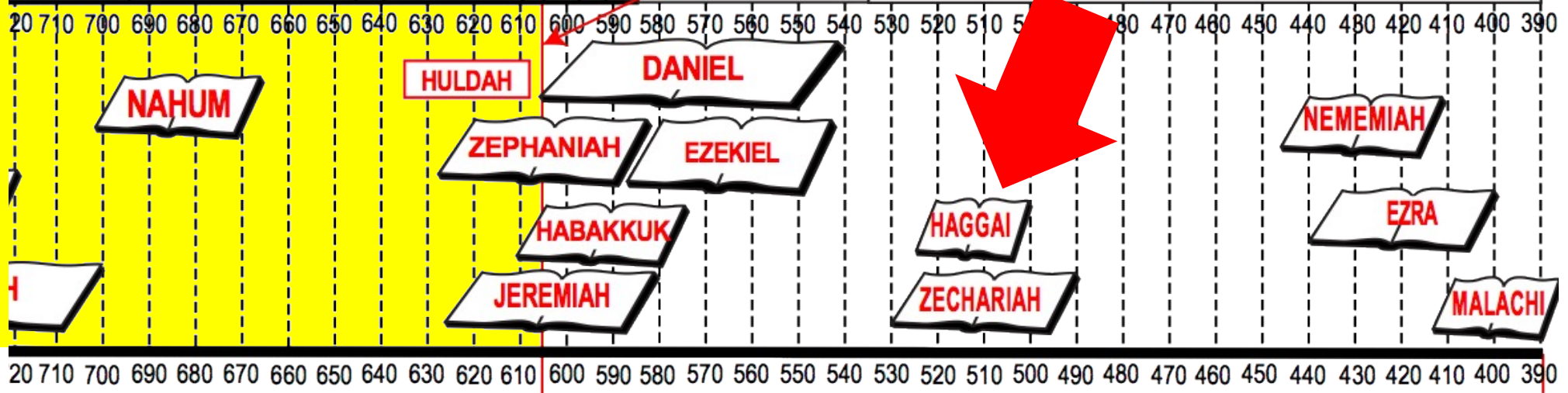
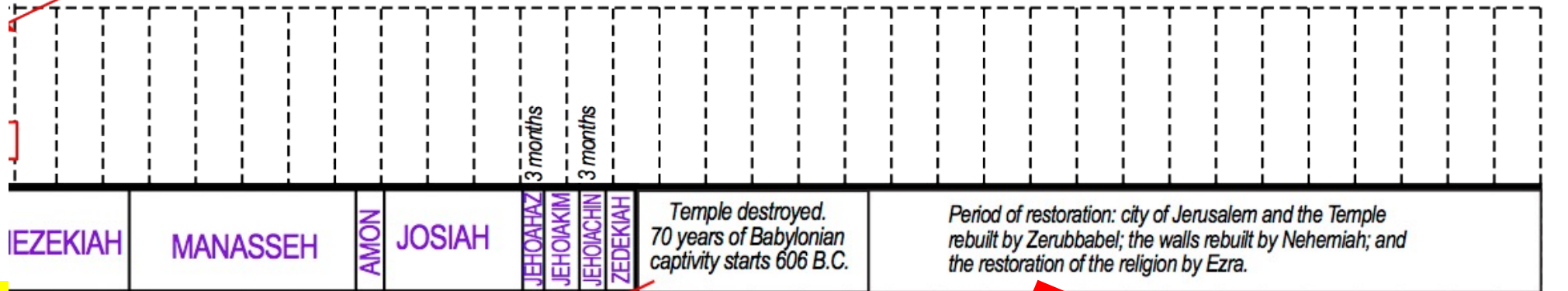

 Only the southern two tribes of Judah and Benjamin remain as the Kingdom of Judah.



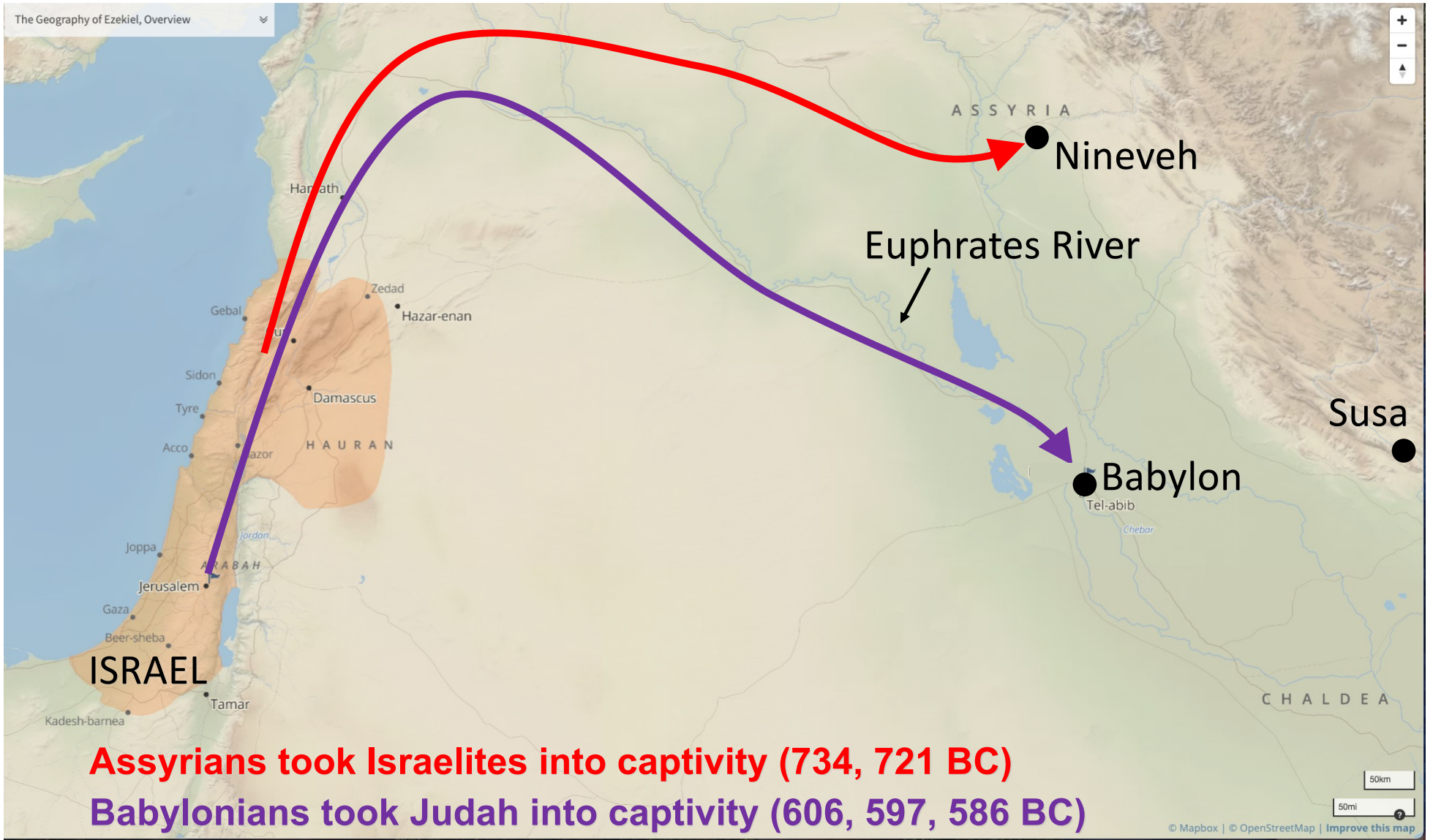

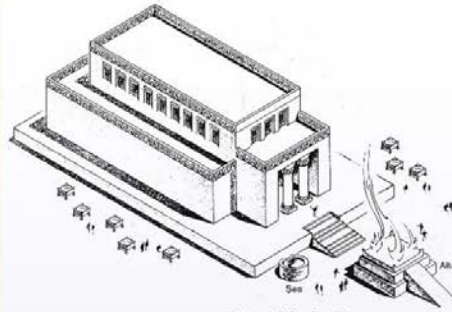
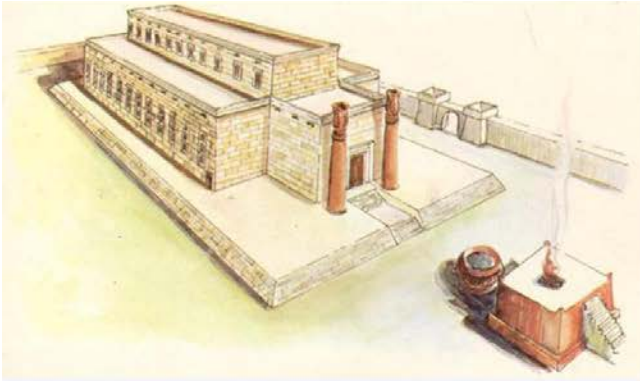
The "Practical Prophet" (Haggai = Festive, festival)

Received communication from God - 26X

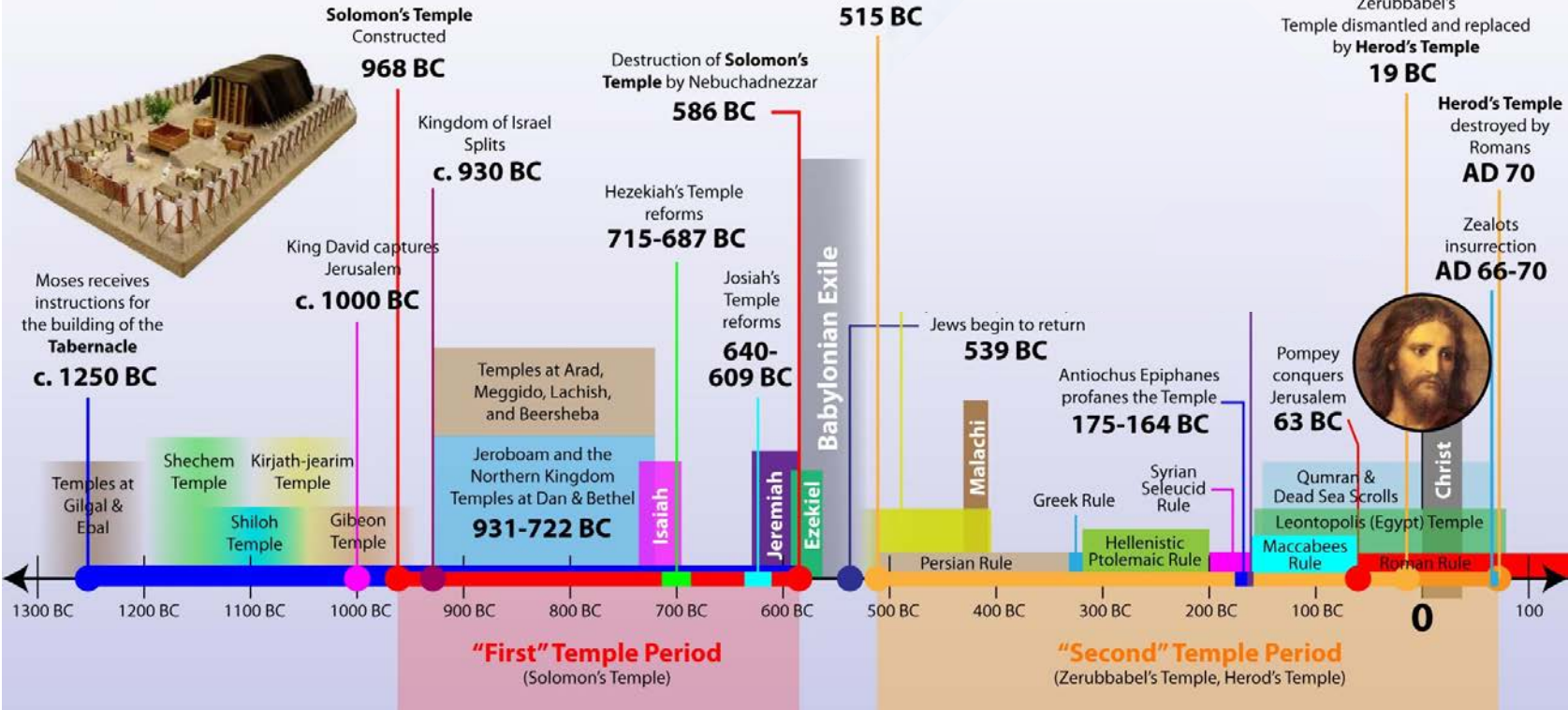

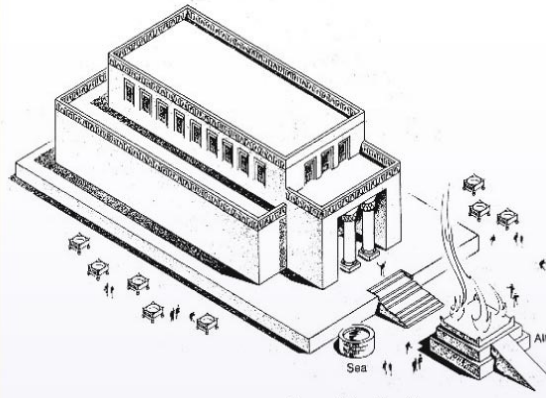
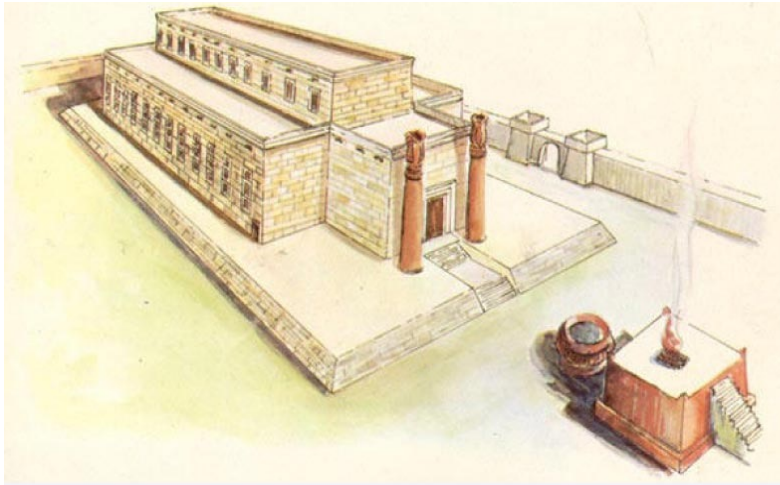


Zerubbabel's reconstruction of Temple completed 515 BC

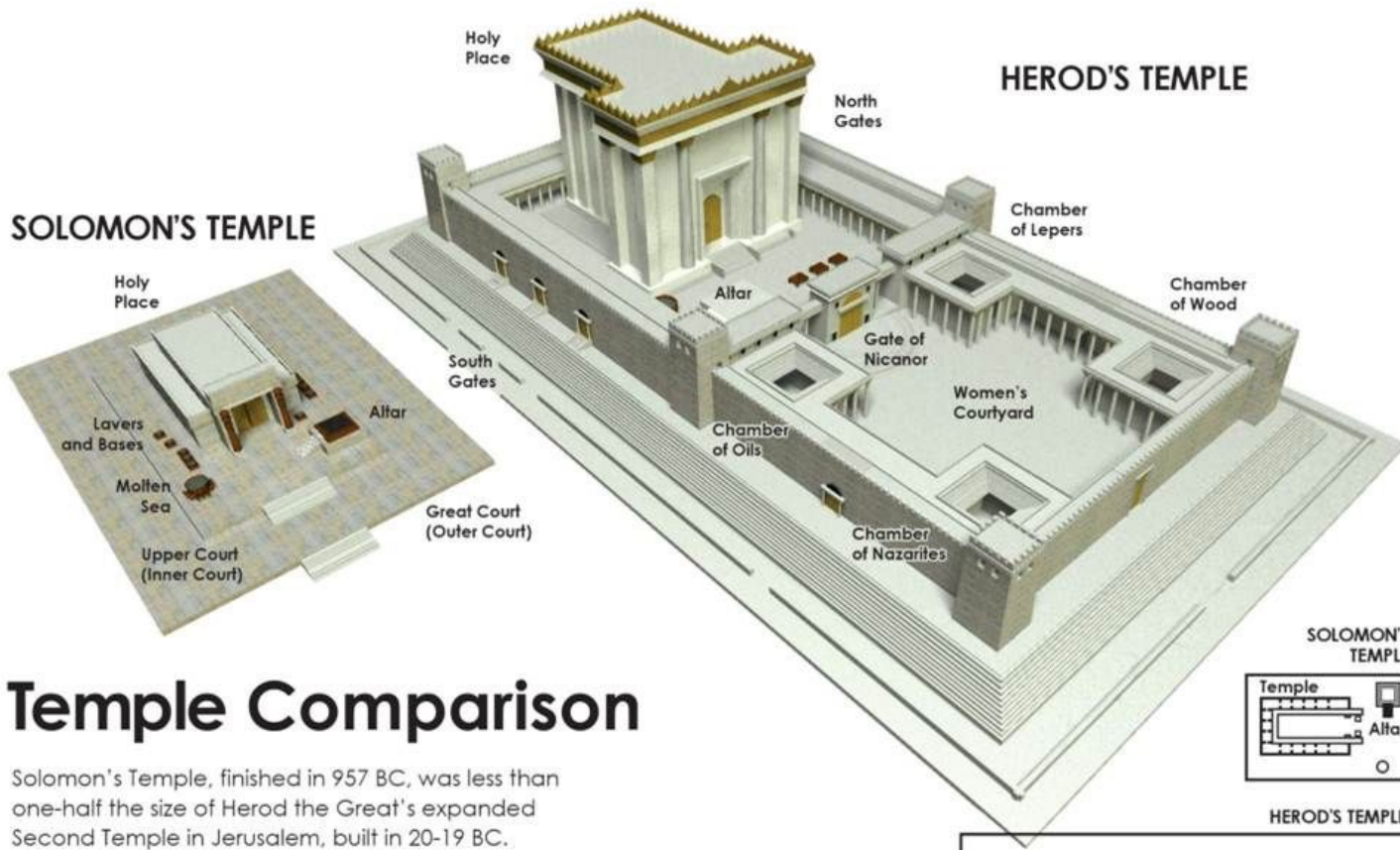

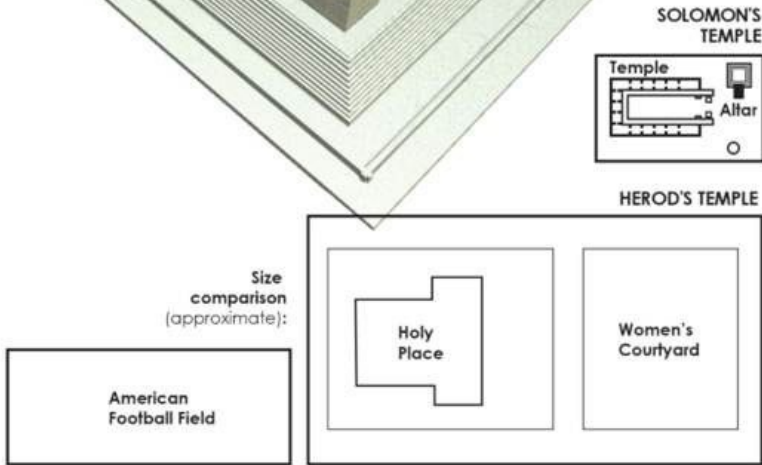
"First" Temple Period

(Zerubbabel's Temple, Herod's Temple)

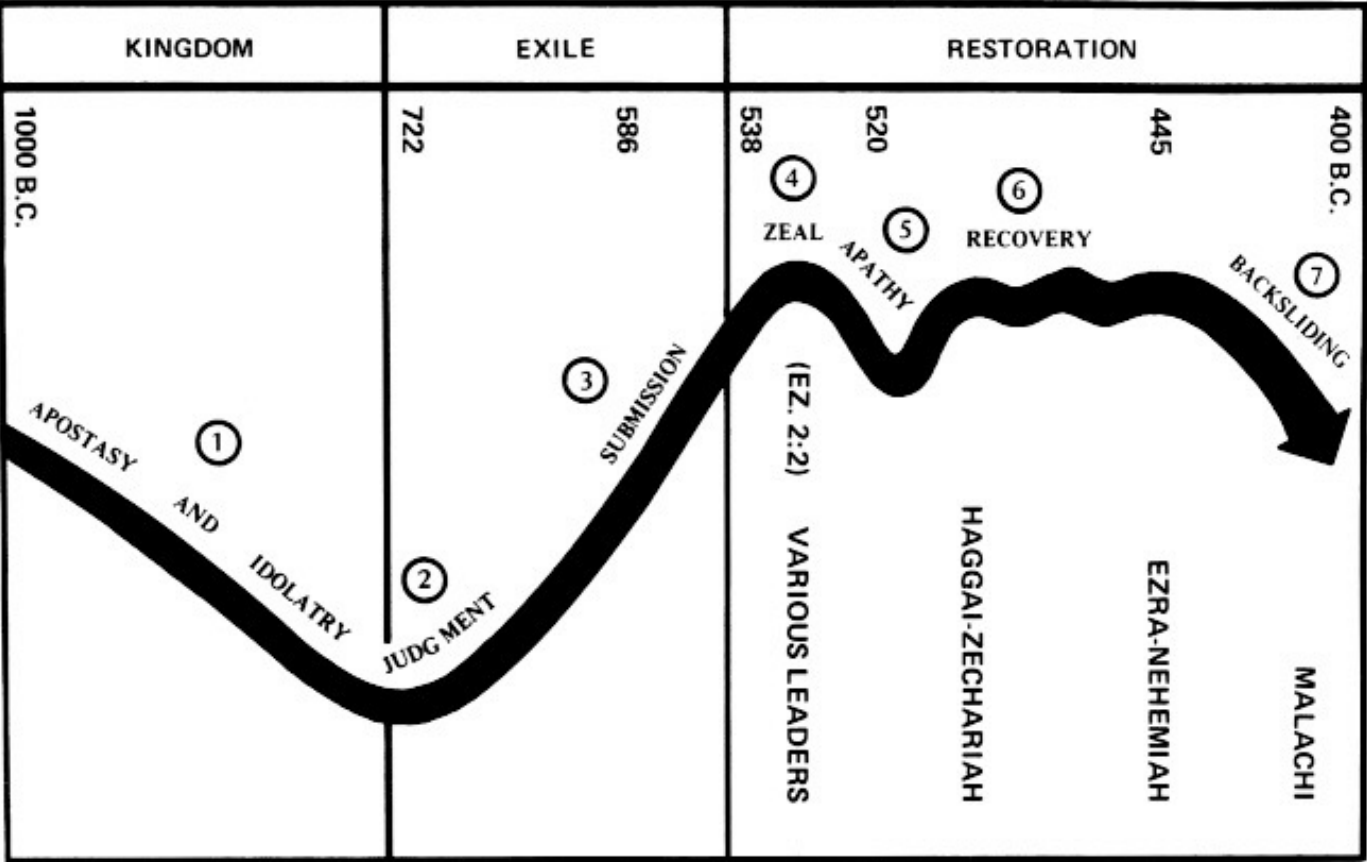


Temple Comparison

Solomon's Temple, finished in 957 BC, was less than one-half the size of Herod the Great's expanded Second Temple in Jerusalem, built in 20-19 BC.
