PENMAN: MOSES (Joshua) POSITION: OT - Pentateuch
PERIOD: 1400 BC (before death of Moses) PLACE: Moab (Across from Jericho)
PHASE: Mosaical; Wilderness PUBLIC: Hebrews / Mankind

KEY POINT:

Orations (4 sermons) Repeat of Law (New Generation)
(Historical sequel) Major cultural change is coming!
Know God. Love God. Obey God. (Because God loves us)
Spiritual emphasis, call to total commitment God.

GREAT LESSONS:

All the laws = all that God expects of us!

Reminded of deliverance; charge to obey God's commandments.

Warnings against materialism / how to live in this world.

Teach your children the faithfulness and ways of the Lord.

Moses charges Joshua (2 Tim 2:2)

God fulfills His promises (about to receive land promise).

MY FAITH:
