PERIOD: 1380 BC (conquest 1440) PLACE: Moab, Canaan

PHASE: Mosaical; (6) Conquest PUBLIC: Hebrews / Mankind

KEY POINTS:

Conquest and Occupation - Victory!

Continuation of Hebrew history - inheritance of land.

Leadership and victory (Joshua = "Savior")

Moses taught how to live in land - Joshua applies teaching

Jericho and Rahab (Heb 11)

(Aí & Achan) Sin contaminates - discipline necessary.

Deception of the Gibeonites

The Law - recorded and read (1:8) + Borders defined.

Fulfillment of the land promise! Purpose accomplished.

Incredible miracles: waters, Jericho, hailstones, sun

Parallel between Joshua and Acts - established community
