PLACE: Canaan


PHASE: Mosaical; (7) Judges

PUBLIC: Hebrews / Mankind


KEY POINTS:

Decline and Oppression (7x)

Continuation of Hebrew history (350 years) "dark ages." Lack of leadership - Cycle of: faith to apostasy. Israel's need for a Messiah, a godly king.

5	WILDERNESS WANDERING	- 1450 B.C.	Ex. 15:1 - Josh. 3:17
6	CONQUEST OF CANAAN	- 1430 B.C.	Joshua 4:1 - Judges 3:9

(2) Idolatry; (3) Pagan wives = influence
