

In the Big Leagues, the greatest hitters hit safely approximately 3 out of 10 times. That means that they make 7 outs in every 10 at bats. Failure is a part of the game. Participating in such a long season, great players must endure, learn from their mistakes, and then forget about those previous at bats, moving on to the next. We've heard that scenario used to discuss the "long season" of life we live, and the sinfulness and mistakes that occur within it. Romans 3:23 says that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. All of that is true. We are sinful creatures, and through the duration of life we will continue to make mistakes. W, too, have a great opponent who has mastered his craft. He knows our weaknesses and how to set us back. Again, that shouldn't deter us, but be a motivator to be better. Just like in baseball, we need to approach our faith with the mentality of no fall-backs, no excuses, no safety nets... We won't settle for less than our best. 
