PERIOD: ~610 B.C. PLACE: Judah


PHASE: Judah alone PUBLIC: Judah

KEY POINTS:

"Condemnation" of Judah

To shake people out of complacency; urge to return to God Threat of the "Day of the Lord" Prophecy of salvation of remnant



Important Dates:

1095 B.C. - Start of the United Kingdom 596 B.C. - Second deportation of Judean captives

975 B.C. - Division of the kingdom 586 B.C. - Third deportation with destruction of the temple

Only the southern two tribes of Judah and Benjamin remain as the Kingdom of Judah.


722 B.C. - Assyrian captivity of Northern Kingdom 536 B.C. - First return campaign led by Zerubabbel

612 B.C. - Babylonia invade Assyrians 520 B.C. - Completion of the temple rebuilding


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PARTICULARS:

Prophesied during reign of Josiah to Exile; along w/Jeremiah

Consume (5x) Cut (5x)
The Day of the Lord is near (1:14)



GREAT LESSONS:

God hates idolatry! (1:4-6)

The Day of the Lord is a terrible day (1:14-16)

Silver and gold cannot deliver one from judgement (1:18)

Those who seek the Lord will be protected (2:3)

God is in control of all nations (2:4-15)

God brings justice to light (3:5)

Singing is an expression of joy for God's people (3:14)
