Main purpose was to urge people to repent or be conquered The Lord will reject those who reject Him

#### Testament = "Covenant, Agreement"


"signifies a mutual undertaking between two parties or more, each binding himself to fulfill obligations ..."

#### THE HISTORY OF REDEMPTION

- We can find Jesus in every book and on every page.
- The message of the Bible, in short, is this: the Old Testament teaches "Christ is coming," the gospel accounts teach that "Christ has come," and the remaining NT books teach that "Christ is coming back again."
- Redemption is prophesied in Genesis 3:15 and fulfilled in John 3:16, (Galatians 4:4), and to the last verse of Revelation is all part of God's plan!



Name means "Appointed by Yahweh"


Largest of the Major Prophets in content
