Scruples vs. Doctrine

It is nothing short of astonishing that so many people can have vastly different interpretations of certain Bible passages. Yet, it is not a new problem. It's been mankind's tendency since the Garden of Eden (cf Gen 3:1-6) and even Paul dealt with the issue, as evidenced in many of his letters (cf. Rom 6:1; 1 Cor 15:12; Gal 1:9; 1 Tim 1:3). Having a strong, clear understanding of Biblical mandates and Christian principles requires one to diligently study the Scriptures and learn to practice grace. This is the main point Paul makes in Romans 14. In that passage, brethren



understood the Bible one way while others saw it a different way - eating all things, or not (v2); esteeming one day over another (v5); what is clean or not (v14). Essentially, they were allowing their personal scruples to override sound doctrine. Paul is teaching that we must learn to separate our personal scruples from doctrine.

What are scruples? Probably the most simple definition is, "they are personal, moral principles or beliefs that make you unwilling to do something that seems wrong." They are found in every aspect of our lives. For example, some people have no qualms about driving faster than the speed limit, while others do. Most would

agree that stealing a car is wrong, but what about stealing intellectual property, like copy and pasting something off the internet that is copyrighted? The same is true concerning religious things. There is usually a Biblical command or principle that can be applied to most of life's issues, but where does one draw the line on some of those issues? That's where scruples come in. We have to make a judgment call. Yet, some Christians place their scruples above doctrine.

Doctrine simply means teaching, or instruction. What is often implied from the word is "rigid command." That's because the teachings or instructions from God, Jesus, or the Apostles are not negotiable. They are to be obeyed. It is the nuances (as in expediencies) of how to fulfill the command that becomes fertile ground for scruples. For example, we are commanded to partake of the "fruit of the vine" (Luke 22:18-20), but how are we to partake of it? Some interpret it as using only one cup, others infer that multiple, plastic cups are acceptable. To be adamantly unyielding about one or the other is a form of being scrupulous. In this particular case, could not both be acceptable in the spirit of unity? That's the type of point Paul is making in Romans 14 about causing one to stumble (14:13).

In conclusion, I want to share a portion of an article that the late, Jay F Guin, a former lawyer, and an elder in the church of Christ, wrote about this subject. The article was titled, <u>The Fork in the Road: Scruples, Part 1</u>. His points and final solution are absolutely accurate. He wrote, "When we run our congregations to suit the sensibilities of our most easily offended members, we make these weak brothers – usually brothers with very bad theology - into de facto, unaccountable elders, which is very wrong. Men and women who don't remotely qualify for leadership are given absolute control in many churches by using their easily offended natures as weapons. It's wrong."

"Teaching is the ultimate solution. But you can spend decades on the role of women, divorce and remarriage, mixed bathing, etc., etc., etc. There's no end of 'issues' for people to have scruples over. Far better to talk about the bigger picture and help your members learn how God wants us to understand our faith. ... Particularly, teaching on grace is needed, rather than the particulars of the arguments for or against your position. Members have to be taught that, as Paul says, "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit." [Romans 14:17]

"The solution to doctrinal disagreement is not yielding to the most legalistic [or to the most liberal] in the community. It's both sides learning to yield their scruples to Christ and so to be united despite their disputes." [arrangement and emphasis edits are mine - T.S.]
